Changing UNIX Permissions of a Groupdrive

UNIX permissions currently cannot be meaningfully changed by the user. You can adjust the permission bits (read/write/execute), but you cannot change the owner or the group.

To adjust the permission bits, the drive must be mounted locally with NFS as root. This is generally only possible via a Linux client. Please follow the instructions in [1]Accessing Groupdrives from a Linux Client.
