Before you can use digital signatures, you must have Adobe configured and your certificate included.

- Open the document you want to sign in Adobe. Then click "Tools" in the upper left corner. Opened document			
- Select "Use a certificate". Tool overview			
- Now select "Digitally sign" from the toolbar. Digital signature selection			
- Drag a rectangle at the point where you want the signature. Creation of the signature			
- Select your certificate from the list and click "Next". Certificate selection			
- Enter the certificate's password when prompted. Otherwise, click on "Sign". Password request and confirmation			
- Assign a new file name and save the document. Save signed document			
- Below the toolbar, you can see the validity of the signed document. Signature validity check
