In this guide, you will learn how to set up a TU Dresden email account in Gmail for Android. You can then send and receive emails and view your calendar.

Setup

The instruction was carried out on a Google Pixel 4a with Android 11.

The Gmail app was used, which is pre-installed on most Android smartphones. If you don't have it, you can download it here:[1]Gmail

- Open the Gmail app and click on "Add an email address".

- Now click on "Exchange and Office 365".

- Enter your "mail address" (depending on the ending, only @tu-dresden.de or @mailbox.tu-dresden.de) and then click on "Set up manually".

- Now enter the following data and then click on "Next".

- Password: Your password
- Client certificate: -
- Domain name: user\zih-login
- Server: msx.tu-dresden.de
- Port: 443
- Security type: SSL/TLS
